17th SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

Habakkuk 1:1-4; 2:1-4 Injustice and violence in the time leading up to the Babylonian exile move this prophet to lament: How can a good and all-powerful God see evil in the world and seemingly remain indifferent? God answers by proclaiming that the wicked will perish, but the righteous will live by faith.



Psalm 37:1-9 Commit your way to the Lord; put your trust in the Lord. (Ps. 37:5)

2 Timothy 1:1-14 This message written from Paul to Timothy is a personal message of encouragement. In the face of hardship and persecution, Timothy is reminded that his faith is a gift of God. He is encouraged to exercise that faith with the help of the Holy Spirit.

SHARE YOUR SOLES! - WHAT IF YOU COULD CHANGE THE WORLD? WOULD YOU?

In 1999, Mona Purdy traveled to a remote village in Guatemala and participated in a local running race. While running through this impoverished community, she noticed little children with a black substance on their feet in place of shoes. She later came to find out it was hot tar. These children were putting hot tar on the soles of their feet because they had no shoes protecting them. On her way home, she met an American Orthopedic Surgeon who was visiting this particular village. He explained to her that with shoes, he would be less needed to regularly travel here. He was performing amputations of children's infected limbs due to lack of protection on their feet. For the month of October, we will be gathering all types of footwear including gym shoes, sandals, boots, shoes of all sizes, men's women's and children's. Your gently worn or brand-new shoes of any kind are going to people who may have never even owned a pair. It's important that these shoes are in good condition to respect the dignity of those receiving them. Shoes older than five years old decompose, even if they were never worn. So please: be respectful with your donations, understand that our goal is to provide good, clean shoes to those in need. For example, tennis shoes should include laces and not have holes.
