#### 23rd SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

**MALACHI 4:1-2A** Malachi, whose name means "my messenger," warns that the day of the Lord is coming. On that day, the evil will be destroyed like stubble in a fire, but the "sun of righteousness" will shine on those who fear God.



**PSALM 98** In righteousness will the Lord judge the world. (Ps. 98:9)

**2 THESSALONIANS 3:16-13** Some members of the Thessalonian community, because of their belief in the nearness of Christ's return, had ceased to work, living off the generosity of other members of the community. Paul warns them bluntly that if they want to eat, they need to work.
